




Duvet Covers

- **Closures:** These covers are available with standard zipper or Velcro closures Options include:
 - Tie or flap top
 - Luxurious envelope
- Edge: Can be specified as knife, flange or welt



Yardage:

- 54" fabric requires 12 yards and is joined
- 126" fabric (or fabrics over 110") require 6 years and are seamless on both face and underside
- When specifying flange or welted edges, add one yard of fabric (for either 54" or 126" wide material).

Duvet Inserts

- Continuous filament fiberfill of hypollergenic, siliconized, 100% virgin polyester
- The insert shell is made of preshrunk 70/30 poly/cotton, leak proof, washable fabric
- Fiber is pre-blended and garneted
- Also available is our Natural Down






Reverse Sham







Reverse Sham with Accent Welt Edge





Accent Banded








Bed Scarves



- A decorative accent placed over the duvet or bedspread. It is typically 20" - 25" wide and falls to the top of the bed skirt.
- Face and back can either be the same or contrasting fabrics.
- Edge detail can be knife edge, tape edge, welt or flange.
- Options:
 - Interlined
 - Continuous siliconized 100% virgin polyester
 - Any quilting pattern

Bed Wraps

- A flat draping bed cover that typically covers 50% to 65% of the entire bed and typically drops to the bed skirt.
- Face and back can either be the same or contrasting fabrics.
- Edge detail can be knife edge, tape edge, welt or flange.
- Options:
 - Interlined
 - Continuous siliconized 100% virgin polyester
 - Any quilting pattern








Bed Skirts

Decking: Manufactured using 70/30 polyester/cotton blend or 100% polyester (Fillion)

- Lining: Optional lining is a 70/30 poly/cotton blend or 100% polyester
 - Face fabric on lined bed skirts will have a 1" turn to the back side of the skirt
 - Unlined bed skirts will have a double turned 1" lock-stitched hem
- **Platform Strip:** All of County's bed skirts are manufactured with a 4" platform strip so the decking does not show if the mattress slips
 - The 4" wide strip on all three sides is made from the same fabric as the skirt
- **Size:** Width and length of box spring + the drop which is normally 13" 14" Drops should be calculated 1/2" above the floor

Bed Skirt Options

- Options available to help prevent or minimize slippage:
 - Fitted Cap: A 4" wide strip of decking extending over the top of the bed and and enclosing the top corners to minimize movement (slippage) of the skirt
 - Elasticized Corners: A fitted sheet with elasticized corners holds the bed skirt in place
 - Hugger: A fitted sheet with elasticized banding around the entire perimeter to reduce movement of the bed skirt
 - Grippers: Non-slip triangular corner pads are sewn into the underside of the platform to prevent movement of the bed skirt




Partial view of underside of one elasticized corner





Bed Skirt Hugger




Standard Bed Skirt Styles


Shirred – Gathered on all three sides of the drop with 200% fullness (unless otherwise specified)




Tailored – 3 or 5 inverted pleats. Pleats are placed at the center of the three side drops and one each at the front corners.



Box Pleated – Continuous inverted pleats on all three sides of the drop.



Corner Pleated - 2 inverted pleats at front corners.

Note: Orientation of stripes and patterns in relation to how they are printed (vertical or horizontal) will affect COM yardage calculations

Standard Box Spring Covers

This form fitting fabric cover is an elegant solution that snugly fits over and conceals the entire box spring.

Top Decking: Manufactured using 70/30 polyester/cotton blend or optional 100% polyester (customer may specify preference).

Top Platform Strip: All of County's box spring covers are manufactured with a 4" platform strip so the decking does not show if the mattress slips. The 4" wide strip on all three sides is made from the same fabric as the box spring cover.

Size: Width, length and height of box spring + 2" for ease of installation.


Classic-Zip Box Spring Covers

Zippered Closure: Rather than the fitted sheet style (in which the underside of the mattress is exposed) this is a full-enclosure method wherein the entire box spring is closely surrounded by fabric and, once the box spring is positioned inside, the opening along the bottom seam at the head of the bed can then be zipped closed. This location allows for the zipper to be hidden from guest view. The rest of the construction is the same as the standard style with decking and platform strip. The underside of the cover is made with the same decking material.

Top and Bottom Deckings: Manufactured using 70/30 polyester/cotton blend or optional 100% polyester (customer may specify preference).

Top and Bottom Platform Strips: 4" fabric strips in the same fabric as the box spring case are placed on all four sides on both the upper and underside of the case so the decking does not show if the mattress slips.

Size: Width, length and height of box spring + 2" for ease of installation.



Both Standard and Classic-Zip styles are available with the following options:

- Tailored with pleats on sides and corners
- Closed cap corners

- Flat Wrapped around all four sides
- Quilted

County fabricates an assortment bedding accessories in a variety of sizes and designs with many decorative edge treatments and details.




Throw Pillows

Closure: The standard is a machine-sewn closure but zippered closures are also available.


Fill: Each pillow is hand-filled with down or polyester fiberfill (*customer to specify*) to a medium density. Softer or firmer densities are available but must be specified.

Options: Decorative edgings such as welts, trims, braids and tassels; or center buttons.




Knife Edge Cord Edge






Cord Edge w/ Square Button


Detail of Bolster with contrasting side panel and welt and zippered closure

Closure: The standard is a machine-sewn closure but zippered closures are also available.

Fill: Each pillow is hand-filled with down, polyester fiberfill or foam (customer to specify) to a medium density. Softer or firmer densities are available but must be specified.

Options: Decorative edgings such as trims, braids and tassels; center buttons on ends; end panels can be specified with a contrasting secondary fabric.

Sizes: Typical cylindrical bolsters are available from 4" to 12" in diameter and in any specified length. Custom sizes and shapes are also available.



Pillow Shams


Standard pillow sizes: Full (27" x 21"), Queen (30" x 21"), King (36" x 21") and Euro (26" x 26").

Closure: The standard is a simple envelope closure. Zippers and Velcro are also available.

Edges: Welted, Knife edge and Flange

Welts: 1/4", 1/2" or 1" self-welt with closed edges.

Options: Decorative edgings such as trims, braids and tassels. Front (and back) of sham can also be quilted.



All yardages are estimated. Zipper and Velcro closures require slightly less yardage. Consult factory for exact yardage quotation.

Headboards


County fabricates an assortment of fully upholstered headboards in all standard bed sizes. The core is constructed of plywood with foam or dacron padding. The headboards may be mounted on legs or on a wall cleat.

The contoured tops have single or double rolls that may be flat, shirred or pleated. Shirred Jumbo Cord can replace the contour roll top.

Bedspreads

Filling: Bonded polyester is the standard for commercial bed coverings.

- County's yardage requirements are based on the use of standard 8 oz. fill.
- Other fill weights, such as 6 oz., 10 oz., and 12 oz. are available.

Seams: Fabrics that are 126" wide (based on a 21" drop) are seamless.

- We pre-seam and pattern match all 54" wide fabric prior to quilting.
- All bedspreads are pattern and quilt matched.

Lining: Standard – Pre-shrunk 70/30 polyester/cotton blend, compatible with all face fabrics.

- Upgrade A high count 56/44 cotton/polyester pre-shrunk lining.
- Additional upcharge options: 100% polyester and colored linings.

Hems: Single-needle hems are lock-stitched through quilting to prevent the spread from unraveling and create a 1" self-welt look.

Finish: All corners are mitered for strength.

Options: Welt cord is available from ¼" to 1" to create a border around the width of the bed's top edge or around the bottom perimeter.

Pillow Tuck: The allowance added to cover the pillow

- Economy 15"
- Standard 18"
- Double Stack 30"
- Reverse Sham 36"

Measurements: Indicate bed type: Twin, Double, Full, Queen, King, etc.



Actual measurements, however, will also be requested (width x length x overall height) of bed because of variations in bedding standards. The standard drop from the top of the bed to the floor measures 21". NOTE: Due to increased mattress heights, some bed styles now measure up to 29" or more. Be sure to specify the overall height on all quote requests and orders.



Quilting Patterns


- The quilt patterns are continuous throughout the entire spread.
- The stitches are equal lock-stitches (not chain stitches).
- 8 10 stitches per inch.





Single Onion (3)




Vertical Channel (4)








Coverlets

Coverlet construction techniques and specifications are the same as those noted for quilted bedspreads except that the shorter drop on the sides and foot typically measures 13".

Because the remainder of the bed structure is exposed, showing the box spring, frame and any open area, they are normally used with a bed skirt.

The styles of coverlets are also the same as those mentioned in the Bedspread section:


- Throw with Rounded Corners
- Fitted with Closed Corners
- Fitted with Gussets (quilted or unquilted)
- Fitted with Waterfall Front
- Fitted with Double Kick Pleats



Fitted with Gussetts

Split corners at the foot of the bed with gussett sewn in behind the split. The gussett may be quilted or unquilted unquilted requires an additional 3/4 yard of material.






Coverlet Styles




Bedding Measurements

Measurements required for quoting and production of duvets, bedspreads, coverlets and bed skirts include:

- Width and length of bed
- Coverlet drop
- Bed Skirt drop

Note: Due to the overlap of the coverlet and bed skirt, the two drops should be greater than the overall height of the bed.



- A Width of Bed
- B Length of Bed
- C Drop from Top of Mattress to Floor
- D Height from Top of Mattress to Bottom of Box Spring
- E Distance from Top of Box Spring to Floor
